Amendments to Sailing Instructions version 1.5 and all corrected in version 1.6

Amendment No 1 for All Classes

1.3 Shipping

- (a) Any boat infringing the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea or by-laws in respect of commercial shipping may be penalised or disqualified from one or more races or from the series.
- (b) An engine shall be used when appropriate to avoid risk of collision with another vessel that is under way but not racing; or in grave emergency. The facts shall be reported to the RC at the finish, with written details to the race office before the protest time limit. The protest committee may impose a penalty if it thinks fit.
- (c) This changes RRS 63.1.
