2nd August 2020 NOTICE OF RACE – Amended 27/07/2020

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY (paragraph replaced with)

- 3.1 The RTYC Series is open to the following: • IRC rated boats and RTYC Cruiser Class.
- 3.2 Crews of up to a maximum of 6 people from any household (minimum of 3) or two-thirds of a boat's IRC/RTYC crew number rounded up. This amends IRC rule 22.4. Crew limits will be posted at the RTYC web site. <https://www.rtyc.com/on-the-water/club-results-information/>
- 3.3 The Organising Authority reserves the right to alter or change the eligibility criteria as or when there are changes to Government guidance that affect the eligibility or entry criteria.
- 3.4 Eligible boats should enter using the RTYC online entry system <https://www.rtyc.com/entry-form-2/>
- 3.5 Competitors are reminded, notwithstanding the crew limitations (3.2 above), of the government guidance on social distancing and other Covid19 measures.
- 3.6 Automatic and wind-vane devices for steering are permitted (this changes RRS 52)
- 3.7 Management of the crews (track and trace and a log of crew triage) must be kept for each race.

9 COMMUNICATIONS

- 9.3 All vessels fitted with an AIS system are requested to switch the system on for the duration of the race. It is the intention to monitor the race using the AIS system.

Note to Competitors.

It is the intention of the Race Committee that the races will form part of a RTYC series of races with discards, which will all be subject to Government guidelines and further advised as they are announced.

The proposed schedule of races will be every Sunday until the end of October with 13 races including 5 discards.
